Key Responsibilities:

- Working alongside the Assistant Resort Manager and locally run hotels and ski schools to deliver the Powder Byrne product
- Training and managing the Powder Byrne resort team and Assistant Resort Managers and staff motivation
- Client concierge and pre-tavel client requirements, as well as ski guiding and airport ransfers if required
- Liaising locally on behalf of Powder Byrne guests, including hotels, restaurants and transport authorities
- Carrying out daily correspondence relating to administration (e.g. expenses, client payment forms, operational feedback)
- Carrying out all planning and logistics for every peak week alongside the Delivery Team and Assistant Resort Manager
- Assisting with Client Concierge and any pre-travel client requirements
